

RYDE ROWING CLUB.

Club and Member Actions in the Event of a Positive Covid-19 Test.

Anyone who has had a positive Covid-19 test must not attend the Club in any way until after the end of their quarantine period – this includes the main Clubhouse in Appley Park and our boathouse facility at the Folly.

Anyone suspecting they are or may be infected should not attend the Club for a period of 14 days or until they have been tested and the test results are negative.

The affected person must promptly inform the Club Captain – Graham Reeve, the Rowing Captain – Joel Smith, the Safety Adviser Steve Draper and the Junior Coordinator Steve Bull of their positive test. This includes junior members. Information to be provided to include: other crew members and others known to be at the Club or Folly at that time and if applicable the boat and blades used (where known) and whether the changing room and boathouse was entered.

The Club Captain, Safety Adviser and or Junior Coordinator will liaise and one of them will inform the membership by email of the positive test and the known details. [The identity of the affected person will not be publicised.]

One of them will also contact crew members identified and inform them of the positive Covid test and instruct that they should self-isolate and are not allowed to come to the Club for a period of 14 days.

If possible the boat and blades used will be taken out of circulation for a period of 3 days and should be cleaned thoroughly before the next outing by the first people to use it once it is back in circulation – and anyone who has used the boat and blades after the potentially infected person should be contacted too and warned.

Where blades cannot be identified, it will be communicated to members that they must wash all blades in use before their next outing until 3 days after the infection/suspected infection was reported.

If the affected person entered either changing room or the boathouse the changing room will be closed for a period of 3 days.

The Committee will continue to monitor the situation and Government advice on preventing the spread of Covid-19. If it is decided that additional measures are required, this will be communicated to the membership. The measures set out above will remain in force until the membership is informed otherwise.

By taking these steps the Club should be able to limit to the extent possible infection spreading through the membership. The Committee believes that, by taking those steps set out above, it would not be necessary to close the Club for a period of 14 days after any notified infection
